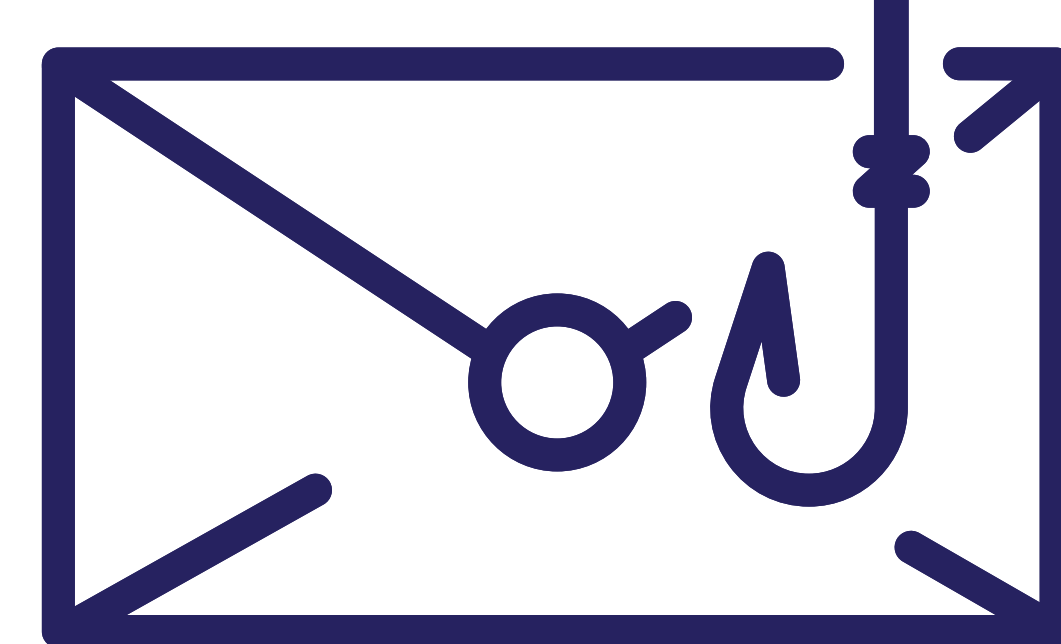


Ransomware attacks:

Data breach statistics show that SMBs can spend up to
